- 1) This grant application and all required supporting documents such as IRS letter attesting to 501 (c) (3) status, copy of most recent 990 tax return and, for facilities with equines, a completed Veterinarian Report and attending Vet letter, are required to be postmarked by April 1st.
- 2) All applicants must be fulfilling a portion of the TCA mission of providing “a better life for Thoroughbreds, during and after their racing careers, by supporting retirement, rescue and research and by helping the people who work with them.”
- 3) All applications should be typed or clearly printed.
- 4) Grant application should be concise and complete. Please do not use three-ring binders or other bulky packaging and do not submit videos, audiocassettes or DVD's.
- 5) All applications will be reviewed and considered at our Board of Directors meeting in May/June of each year. For all approved applications, grants will be processed shortly thereafter, and received in June.
